Saba is accessible from outside the departmental network!

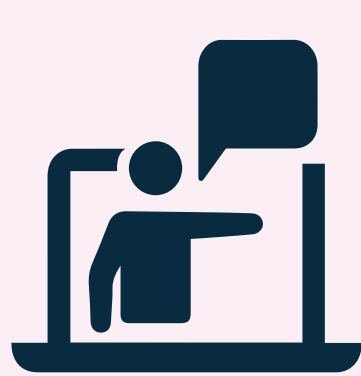
If you are not providing critical services to Canadians, talk to your manager about participating in Saba (<https://esdc.sabacloud.com>) eLearning activities.

New ESDC Mandatory Training Deadline

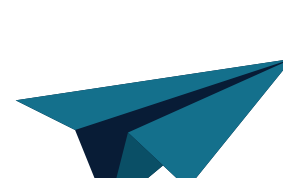
The deadline for all employees to complete their mandatory training has been extended to December 31, 2020. More news to follow!
