Consult, consider, report and make decisions on local OHS matters.

Regional Health and Safety Advisory Committees
Participate, inform, report and make recommendations on regional matters.

Regional OHS Advisors

Promote, monitor and evaluate the Departmental OHS Program at the regional level.

Informs and provides advice and guidance to senior management, the PHSC and ROHSA.

Liaises with regulatory agencies and other government departments.

Workplace Health and Safety Committees & Representatives
Participate, inform, report and make recommendations on local matters.

Inform and provide advice and guidance to workplace health and safety committees / health and safety representatives, Regional Health and Safety Advisory Committees, RADM/ADM and local and regional management.

Managers / Supervisors / Team Leaders
Consult, consider, report and make decisions on local OHS matters and implements.
